We are seeking nominations from individuals who wish to participate in the Support at Home Assessment Trial Advisory Group. The Advisory Group will provide ongoing advice during a trial of the proposed assessment model for the new [Support at Home program](#) that will begin in July 2023.

We are seeking representatives from the aged care sector including:

- aged care service providers who deliver Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP), Home Care Package (HCP), Short-Term Restorative Care (STRC) or residential respite services
- experienced aged care assessors
- geriatric and allied health professionals
- senior Australians and their family and carers who have experience with home care services.

The Advisory Group will consider:

- administration of the needs assessment approach and outcomes. It will recommend methods that could be tested throughout the trial period.
- techniques and training required to administer the needs assessment.
- needs assessment outcomes and how they will allow service delivery partners to respond to consumer's changing needs over time.
- insights and issues identified during the trial. It will propose possible actions to resolve issues.
- issues and/or feedback about the experience of consumers, assessors, and service providers during the trial.
